Lord, send us the people no one else wants. Lord, send us your treasures, that we may treasure them as you would.

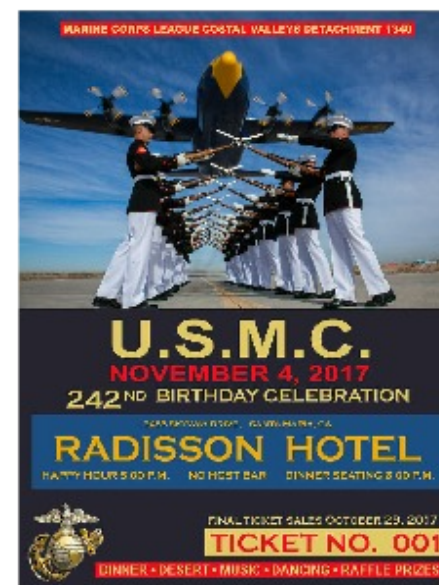
